RPG has been working to gather all the necessary requirements that needed to be met to proceed yearly without applying for authorization. Agencies of the Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks (MECP), Fisheries and Oceans Canada (DFO) Algonquins of Ontario (AOO), and NDMNRF have all been satisfied.

The goal of this amendment is to lessen impacts from severe flooding. It is also the first successful amendment to be processed with the new MNRF Technical bulletin.
